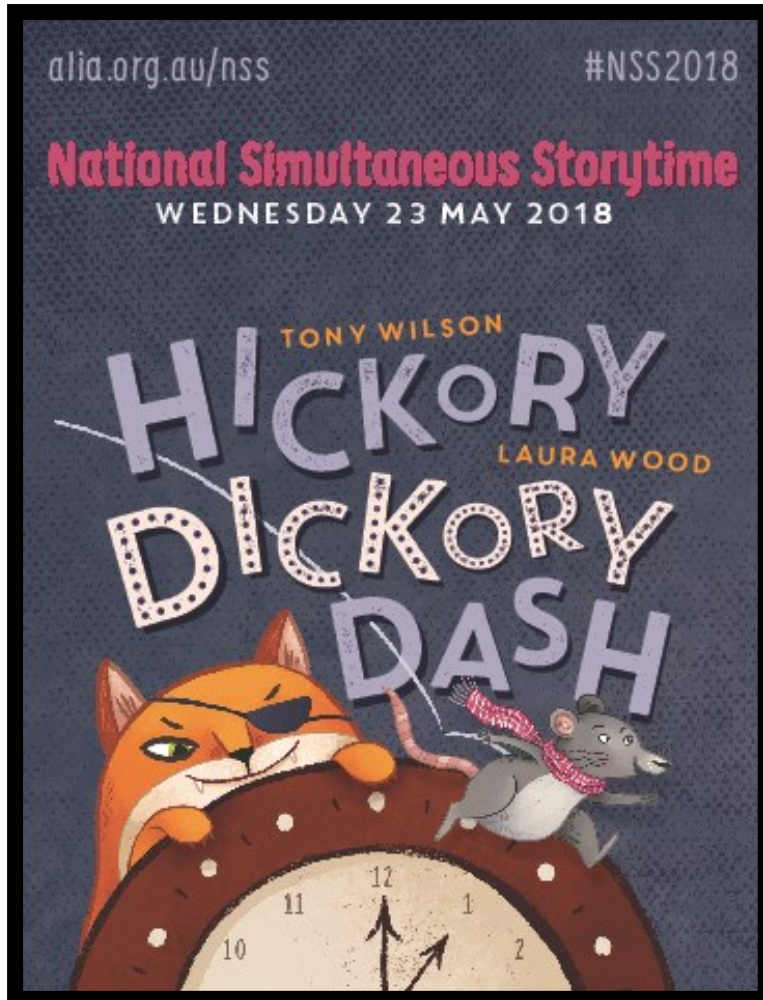

BUSWAYS SCHOOL OPAL CARDS

Throughout this term, inspectors from Busways are visiting our school in an attempt to ensure each student presents an Opal Card for their bus travel. Regular use of the card is important as it provides data to the company regarding numbers of passengers travelling on each bus.

It is essential that any student travelling by bus presents a valid School Opal Card or a Child/Youth Opal Card, or they will be asked to pay a fare.

If your child is unable to present a valid Opal Card or bus fare, the bus driver will record their name and notify the school.
