Spelling

On Thursday's Years 3-6 focus on the Etymological Strategy; where words come from.

- The strategy involves looking at the origin and meaning of words.
- Part of etymological language is looking at a root word and finding as many words as possible that come from that root word.

For Example;

Root word - **geo** | Origin - **Greek** | Meaning - **the earth**

geology
geometry
geography
geographic
geophysics
geothermal
geoscience

Students are encouraged to use dictionaries to find more words and discover their meanings.

On Thursdays, Years K-2 focus on revising spelling strategies from throughout the week; Phonological, Visual and Morphemic. Etymological is touched on as needed.

Next week we will be discussing the **Visual Strategy**.
