Pope Francis has set aside today, March 2, as a Day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace in Ukraine. At our Ash Wednesday Liturgy today, Father Tomy said to our children that Lent is a time where we can all pray more.

As we begin our Lenten journey, let's encourage our children to set aside some time where they can talk to God.

Encourage your children to pray for those less fortunate and for strength in their own lives. RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Wednesday, 2 March 2022 is Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the season of Lent. You will see the Priest's vestments and the colour used on prayer tables and on the altar is purple, which represents a time for preparation and waiting. Lent lasts a period of forty days. It is a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving (giving to others). Through prayer we come closer to God. Fasting joins us in solidarity with the poor. Almsgiving (giving) is a sign of our commitment to justice.

The Fast Life

Fast from judging others; Feast on Christ dwelling in them. Fast from fear of illness; Feast on the healing power of God. Fast from words that pollute: Feast on speech that purifies. Fast from discontent; Feast on gratitude. Fast from anger; Feast on patience. Fast from pessimism; Feast on hope. Fast from negatives; Feast on encouragement. Fast from bitterness: Feast on forgiveness. Fast from self-concern: Feast on compassion. Fast from suspicion; Feast on truth.

Fast from gossip; Feast on purposeful silence. Fast from problems that overwhelm; Feast on prayer that sustains. Fast from anxiety; Feast on faith.

THE COMMUNITY COTTAGE





Lake Munmorah Catholic Schools Community Cottage, more commonly known as The Cottage, supports the Early Learning Centre, St Brendan's and St Brigid's School community. The Cottage has staff available to help, listen, provide support, and link with external agencies, no matter how big or small the issue or problem may appear.

Within The Cottage is the School Counsellor, Family Liaison Officer, and Family Support Advocate. We run a range of programs for students and parents: playgroup, transition support, resilience programmes, emotional regulation, financial counselling support, 123 Magic, Circles of Security, and support groups. We are also creating links with external agencies that can help support families, including CatholicCare, Interrelate and Youth Mental Health.

Natalie Ross - School Counsellor

Natalie Ross is a Registered Psychologist and her role at St Brendan's is School Counsellor. Natalie can support with individual counselling for students across a range of areas including anxiety, grief and loss, behavioural concerns, parental separation, self-harm/suicidal ideation and safety planning, and relationships/social communication. Natalie can also conduct educational and mental health assessments with students and make recommendations for appropriate support and interventions.

Rebecca Leahy - Family Liaison Officer (FLO)

Rebecca provides family support and parent engagement strategies to the school community to build strong family/school partnerships. The FLO facilitates St Brendan's Playgroup and Parent Education initiatives.

The FLO identifies services, agencies and support networks in the community to respond to the complex needs of families and works closely with the school counsellor, Family Support Advocate and other services to provide family support.

Amanda Pilley- Family Support Advocate

Amanda's role is to help support families with various needs and challenges by providing clinical services or referring to internal and external support services. She provides continuity of care by working with families and the school in response to their needs.
