HIGHER ABILITY and GIFTED LEARNERS

Four Red

Over the term Year 4 has combined their skills to further enhance their learning in mathematics. This week they expanded their knowledge on Area. Students were given a real-life task:

Mrs Ward is expanding her paddock for her new animals. Design paddocks for chickens, ducks, goats, and alpacas. Calculate the area and perimeter for each paddock, with one grid box equaling 100m.

To extend students who were able to correctly calculate both area and perimeter, they were asked to then create their own measurements, extending their knowledge, and engaging their higher-order thinking.
